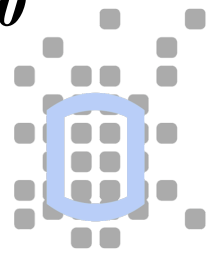


The Chapel - Mission Experience 2010



Objective: To broaden the scope of the high school youth department ministry focusing on worship, service, and evangelism.

Location: Toronto, Canada – CSM Center for Student Missions
Dates: June 19 – June 26, 2010
Cost: \$375

We will be continuing our partnership with CSM for a fourth consecutive year. This experience focuses on serving both physical and spiritual needs. CSM exists to bring students and adults in to the inner city for ministry. CSM is an experience in which students come to know God in a new way. CSM finds places in urban centers for students to use their gifts to promote the Kingdom of God. We do not create our own projects, but link with existing churches and agencies to help them with their ministries. Cost: \$375

We will be working with World Vision this year. World Vision is a Christian humanitarian organization dedicated to working with children, families and their communities worldwide to reach their full potential by tackling the causes of poverty and injustice. Our team will work with World Vision to tackle the causes of poverty by equipping and empowering distressed youth and their families to access the resources and knowledge they need to build a brighter future. The general nature of the trip is a physical project geared at addressing physical needs through repairs and renovations, and addressing spiritual needs through vacation bible schools.

Cost: \$375

Requirements:

Interview Process

1. **This is the most important part of the application process!**
2. A student must schedule an interview to be considered for the trip. At least one parent or guardian will be required to attend the interview. (20 minutes per interview) **The final question in the online application is where you schedule your interview.** It is essential that you select 3 **different** time slots. We will post these slots on zeroautomatic.com/missions.
3. There will be 4 scheduled interview days at both campuses.
 - o Interviews at **Akron** and **Green** will be on:
 - Wednesday, February 10, 2010 from 4PM-6PM (2 hours) 11th & 12th Grades
 - Saturday, February 13, 2010 from 9AM-12PM (3 hours) 11th & 12th Grades
 - Wednesday, March 10, 2010 from 4PM-6PM (2 hours) 9th & 10th Grades
 - Saturday, March 13, 2010 from 9AM-12PM (3 hours) 9th & 10th Grades

Team Make-up:

The criteria for team placement will include interview, year in school, your gifts & your desires.

Participation in D-Groups:

Students must be regularly attending a D-Group or involved in another bible-based Chapel small group. If you are not currently in a D-Group, please see anyone in Student Ministries to help get you into one.

Regular Attendance at Worship Service:

Students must be regularly attending a Worship Service in either Akron or Green.

Trip Training (Mandatory):

Training dates for trips will be **May 8, 15, 22 and June 5**. The training will take place from 9AM to 12 PM. (Location to be determined)

Participation in International:

A student wishing to receive support from the Global Missions Department must be a member of The Chapel. This support is only available for the trip to South Africa. There are three steps to becoming a member.

- 1) Attend "Foundations of Faith" Class or listen to the online audio
- 2) Have brief interview with Steve or Brett
- 3) Register for and attend a one session membership class (info on zeroautomatic.com)

Application Process:

The application has been streamlined and highly automated. The process will be complete once a student completes the following three steps

1. _____ Complete the application online at www.zeroautomatic.com/missions
2. _____ Turn in completed medical release form
3. _____ Remit a \$50 deposit to secure your place on the trip. (Refundable if not selected)

***Both the deposit and the medical form will be due by the time of the interview**
